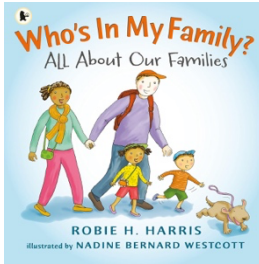




Reception Newsletter- 18.9.23

Things to do to help at home:

Encourage your child to be independent;

e.g putting on their own coat and their shoes, taking their jumper off and putting it on, opening their own bottle and snack pot etc.

Share and discuss stories together as often as possible.

Make a note of the books you share together at home in your child's Reading Diary.

Encourage your child to talk about what they have done at school and see what they can remember.
