


Reception Newsletter - 9.10.23



This week we will learn what a Harvest festival is and when it usually takes place. We will learn about how food is harvested and talk about traditions from the past. We will share 'The enormous turnip' story and learn some songs and rhymes linked to Harvest.



PHONICS

We will learn to say, recognise and write:

/i/ as insect

/n/ as in net

We will practise orally blending and segmenting words with these sounds:

p-i-n/ n-i-p/ p-i-t/ t-i-n



MATHS

We will learn about the composition of numbers 3 and 4.

e.g 3 is composed of 2 and 1.

We will teach & use the following vocabulary:

makes, altogether, collection, subitise

WAYS TO SUPPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME:

Practise forming numbers 1-5 using the rhymes we use in school.

Explore/find different ways to make 3 and 4.

Practise writing the letters/words of the week accurately. Use the rhymes we use in school!

Talk about 'Harvest' and encourage your child to recall what they have learnt in school.
