PHONICS

We will learn to say, recognise and write:

/m/ as in mouse

/d/ as in dog

We will practise orally blending and segmenting words with these sounds:

m-a-n/m-o-p/S-a-m/m-a-d/d-i-p/s-a-d



MATHS

We will develop the children's subitising skills and their positional language.

We will teach & use the following mathematical vocabulary:

subitise, match, above, below, beside, next to, on top

WAYS TO SUPPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME:

Practise using positional language.

Encourage and support your child to describe the position of different things using the key vocabulary in a sentence. E.g the cup is on top of the book.

Support your child to form the numbers 1-5

Practise forming the letters and writing the words of the week.
