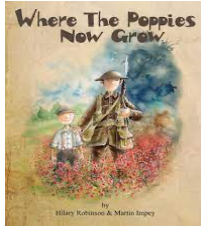




Reception Newsletter - 13.11.23

PHONICS

Practise forming the numbers 1-5 at home. Collect different amounts of objects and compare them using the new taught vocabulary.

Practise recognising and writing all of the letters we have taught so far and reading and writing the words listed above.
