


Reception Newsletter - 20.11.23

WAYS TO SUPPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME:

Ask your child to find an example of an object with parts that go together to make the whole item e.g a drinks bottle has different parts; a top, the bottle and the straw.

Support your child to read their decodable book and read and discuss their class library book with them.
