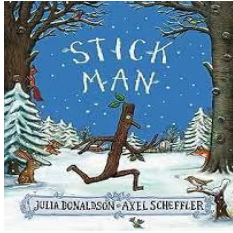




# Reception Newsletter - 4.12.23
