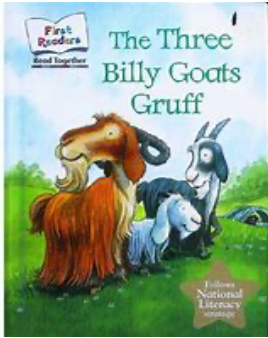




Reception Newsletter- 19.2.24



Our story this week is 'The three Billy Goats Gruff'. We will learn to retell the story in our own words and discuss what happens at the beginning, in the middle and at the end. We will design and make bridges using various resources and order goats by their size. We will also use mixed collage materials to make our own trolls. We will discuss what produce comes from goats and use our senses to explore goats cheese.

Things to do to help at home:

- Support your child to retell the story of the three Billy Goats gruff in their own words.

- Support your child to read their decodable book to you and write in their reading diary.
