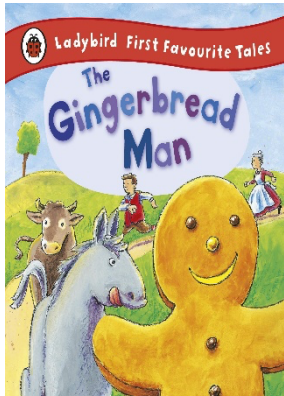




Reception Newsletter- 26.2.24

We will design and decorate our own Gingerbread men. We will practise our cutting skills and use different loose parts and other media and materials to make our own characters from the story.

Please also practise reading and writing the following Common Exception Words:

they, all, are, my, her, you



In Maths we will be continuing to learn about the composition of numbers up to 10.

We will be using the following mathematical vocabulary:

altogether, part, whole, more

Things to do to help at home:

- Support your child to read their decodable book to you and write in their reading diary.
- Play the new red board game to help your child learn to read and write set 3 common exception words. Look out for these words in the books you share together at home.
- Prompt your child to retell our story of the week in order in their own words.
- Support your child to recall different ways to make the same number. They may benefit from using a set number of objects and physically separating them into 2 parts/groups in as many different ways as possible.
