## Things to do to help at home:

- Ask your child about what a bean needs to grow and how it changes as it grows.
- Prompt your child to retell our story of the week in order in their own words.
- Support your child to write the numbers to 10 accurately.
- Support your child to read their decodable book to you and write in their reading diary.
- Play the red board game to help your child learn to read and write set 3 common exception words. Look out for these words in the books you share together at home.
- Challenge your child to think and say a sentence including one of the common exception words or words with our focus sounds of the week in (listed above).
