In Maths we will be focussing on cardinality, ordinality and counting.

We will be using the following Mathematical Key Vocabulary:

represent, amount, count on, forwards, more

Things to do to help at home:

- Look out for and discuss signs of Spring whilst you are out and about together.
- Support your child to read their decodable book to you and write in their reading diary.
- Play the NEW Tricky Word board game to help your child learn to read and write set 4 common exception words. Look out for these words in the books you share together at home.
- Challenge your child to think and say a sentence including one of the common exception words or words with our focus sounds of the week in (listed above).
- Support your child to count on a given amount from any number (using their fingers). E.g count on 4 from 7 to say 11. Count on 6 from 16 to say 22.
