Since schools returned in September, the County Council have received an alarming, unprecedented number of complaints from local residents, parents and in some cases schools themselves, regarding inconsiderate, illegal or sometimes dangerous parking by parents/guardians transporting their child/children to school.

We thank the many families who choose to walk, cycle or scoot to school and those that choose to park further away from the school in a safe considerate manner and walk the remaining (Park and Stride). However, a growing minority are choosing to drive to school and park very close to the school gates, often parking illegally or on the keep clear zigzags and sometimes parking with disregard towards local residents – the school's neighbours. The Parking Enforcement team have been inundated with requests to visit hot spots to try and alleviate this problem and are visiting problem areas as often as they can.

We are taking many steps to encourage and reinforce this message, you will see the new parking buddies in place as a daily reminder.

As we move into the summer term we respectfully ask you to keep our school gates clear!
