## Uniform & Appearance Policy

Fulfen Primary School students wear their uniform with pride. Our uniform shows that we are part of the Fulfen Primary School community. We have the highest expectations from our pupils with regards to school uniform and appearance, and strongly believe that our high standards promote positive behaviour, support effective teaching and learning and contribute to the ethos of the school.

### School Uniform

We have school uniform and we encourage all our children to wear their uniform smartly. All items of uniform must be labelled. School uniform consists of the following:

- white polo shirt or white shirt
- dark blue jumper/cardigan with school logo
- charcoal/grey/black trousers (smart shorts may be worn in warmer weather)
- charcoal/grey/black skirt (blue & white checked dress may be worn in warmer weather)
- grey/white socks
- sensible black school shoes (NOT boots, footwear with heels, open-toe footwear or trainers)

### PE Kit

Children's PE kit, in particular footwear, must be suitable for physical activity so please do not send children with impractical 'fashion' trainer-style footwear.

#### Indoor:

- white t-shirt with Fulfen Logo
- black shorts

#### Outdoor:

- white t-shirt with Fulfen Logo
- black shorts
- trainers
- school hoodies
- navy tracksuit bottoms may be worn in cold weather.

PE kits should be worn to school on their PE days.

### Jewellery:

- Jewellery should not be worn or brought into school.
- If children have pierced ears, one pair of discreet studs may be worn.
- Earrings must be removed for PE lessons for health and safety reasons. If your child is unable to remove the earrings themselves, they should not wear earrings on their PE days (please speak to your child's class teacher for this information).
- No other body piercings are permitted.



## Uniform & Appearance Policy

### Hairstyles and makeup:

- Children should have an appropriate hairstyle for school. For example, tramlines, patterns, sculpting are not permitted and children should not dye their hair inappropriately.
- Children may be asked to tie their hair back for health and safety purposes.
- Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school.

### Footwear:

- Any kind of boots, wellingtons or snow boots may be worn in wet weather/snow but must be changed when inside the school buildings.
- Trainers should not be worn at any time other than for PE days and clubs.

### Non-compliance with the uniform and appearance policy

Parents of Pupils who do not wear the correct uniform may be contacted and requested to bring in a change of clothes for their child. Pupils who wear makeup/nail varnish or jewellery will be required to remove these. Items of jewellery will be confiscated by the teacher to be collected by the parent. Repeated non-compliance of the uniform policy will result in a meeting with parents in order to come to a successful resolution and provide support where necessary.
